In compliance with State and County requirements, we have established the following safety guidelines to protect our staff and customers at the Plymouth Christian School.

- Social Distancing of at least 6' will be enforced.
- Customers must leave 9' spacing between vehicles
- Customers must remain in their vehicle for the duration of the movie. Each vehicle may only be occupied by members of the same household who have already been in close contact with each other.
- Congregating of any type is prohibited.
- Face coverings must be worn when exiting vehicles to visit the restrooms or concessions stand.
- The restrooms will operate at 50% capacity and we will have attendants cleaning and disinfecting and to monitor the number of people who may enter. Men's and Women's restroom will each have a 4 person capacity.
- All concessions will be eaten in your vehicle or directly outside of your own vehicle. Face Coverings and 6' social distancing will be enforced.

- Please do not enter the premises if you are experiencing flu like symptoms or have a fever, a persistent cough or experiencing shortness of breath. Please also do not enter the premises if you have been diagnosed with Covid-19 or have been exposed to someone who has been diagnosed with Covid-19.

You must follow all other guidelines posted at the property as well as CDC and LA County Department of Public Health guidelines.

If you do not follow the above guidelines, you will be asked to leave without a refund.
